As you may have heard, the biggest issue facing the City of Ryde right now is plans for the new Civic Centre towers at Top Ryde.

To the disappointment of many residents, Council approved height controls of up to 24 storeys at the Civic Centre site last month after a split vote of 6 v 6.

I personally think it is totally inappropriate for Council to make a decision with such wide ramifications less than a year away from the next local council elections.

The right thing to do is to put this issue squarely to the people of Ryde for a decision at the next election. Rest assured, I will continue to fight for the right of our residents to have their say.
